

Alcohol policy V.C.M.W. Sigma

Since 1 January 2014 it has been a criminal offence to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. As a study association we are no exception. Serving alcohol to minors will have consequences for the committee, the study association and possibly even the entire faculty. One of the possible consequences could be a blanket ban on serving alcohol. To prevent such draconian ramifications we intend to monitor strictly the legislation regarding serving alcohol to minors and alcohol consumption by minors. Our alcohol policy is set out below.

Alcohol policy

Consuming alcohol at Sigma activities by members under 18 years of age, along with the supply of alcohol to minors, will not be tolerated. Anyone violating this rule will incur the following:

1. The individual concerned will be immediately removed from the premises and issued with a warning.
2.
 - a) In the event of a second violation, if this concerns a minor, the person will no longer be welcome at future Sigma activities where alcohol is served until this individual has reached 18 years of age.
 - b) In the event of a second violation by someone serving alcohol, this individual will be removed from this activity immediately and be banned from future Sigma activities where alcohol is served. The Board will decide the length of the ban.
